TEACHING ENGLISH TO SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGES

Practical application of the concepts taught in TESOL can be practiced during a 4 week placement at one of our associated ESL campuses. Watching and learning from seasoned professionals is a great way to cement the knowledge and skills developed during the in-class portion of the program.

PROGRAM DURATION

- 8-week Certificate program
- In class: 1.86 months - 8 weeks - 205 hours

TEACHING METHOD

- Classroom (Instructor Led) 106 hours
- Worksite (Onsite Studies) 80 hours
- Worksite (Practicum) 18.5 hours

PROGRAM DELIVERY

- In-Class: Fulltime, 26.5 hours a week - Monday to Thursday 9:00 - 12:00 and 13:00 - 15:30 and Friday 9:00 - 12:00 and 13:00 - 14:30

1. Observation Report: Students complete designated observation tasks, fill in a log, and give honest feedback and opinions.
2. Practicum Lesson: Students lead one lesson and will be graded by their practicum host teachers.
3. Practicum Warmer: Students lead one warm up activity to start off the class and will be graded by their practicum host teachers.
4. Oral Touchback: Oral test questions will be marked on both accuracy and fluency in their speech as well as answer completeness.
5. Self-Reflection Essay: Students must write a 750-word self-reflection essay of their experience in TESOL and the practicum.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS
